Course Format

The course will consist of 60% classroom time and 40% hands on time with foster dogs. The course will run two days a week for three hours a class for 5 weeks.

Schedule of Course Sessions

Each three hour class will be divided into 1.5 hours of class time, two 15 min breaks, and 1 hour of hands on training time with the foster dog.

Course Fees

\$150.

Student Evaluation

The evaluation for this course will be a 1 hour oral exam and practical demonstration of dog handling. Mock conflicts will be presented to the student and they will explain the emotional reaction of the dog and ways to handle the situation.

Fostering Rescue Dogs 101



Course Purpose:

It's a sad fact that thousands of loving dogs are put down every year because of a lack of shelter space. Fortunately there is an answer – **Foster Homes.**

This course will educate prospective foster parents about the joy of fostering and provide them the skills to successfully care and rehabilitate abused, neglected and unloved dogs that just want a forever home.



Course Activities:

60% of the course will be classroom based lectures and open discussion. 40% of time will be in a gymnasium, each person will have a foster dog to practice basic leash techniques, socialization and play time. Introduction to strangers and unusual situations to stress the dog will be simulated. Basic obedience and toy sharing with other dog will be simulated as to represent a dog park environment.
